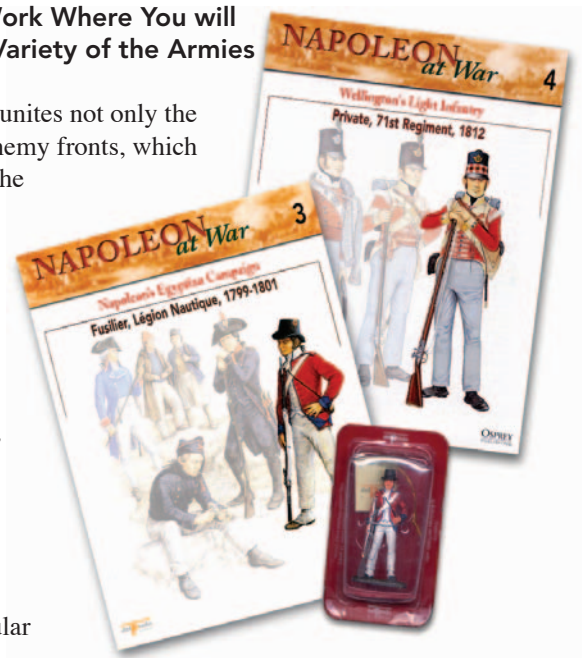
The collection reunites not only the
